A Unique Species

The search for the Agami Heron in Córdoba, Colombia, is justified for several important reasons. First of all, the Agami Heron is an extremely rare and endangered species of bird. Its natural habitat has been significantly reduced due to deforestation and wetland degradation in the region. As a result, it has become increasingly difficult to spot and study this beautiful bird, considered the most beautiful in the world, in its natural environment.

Additionally, the Córdoba region is home to a great diversity of bird species, many of which are endemic or unique to this area. During the expedition in search of the Agami Heron, participants will also have the opportunity to spot and photograph other fascinating species, such as the Boat-billed Heron, the Black Antshrike, the Bicolored Conebill, among many others. This birdlife diversity makes Córdoba a destination of choice for bird watchers and nature lovers who want to explore the beauty and uniqueness of the local fauna.




— General Itinerary

- Day 04. Birding in Mangroves of Cispatá, Caño Palermo & Finca Tomas / Los Garzones International Airport, in Monteria (MTR)






Arrival in Colombia


Exploration in the Sinú River and Boca Negra





Ciénega la Corza & Caño Grande
